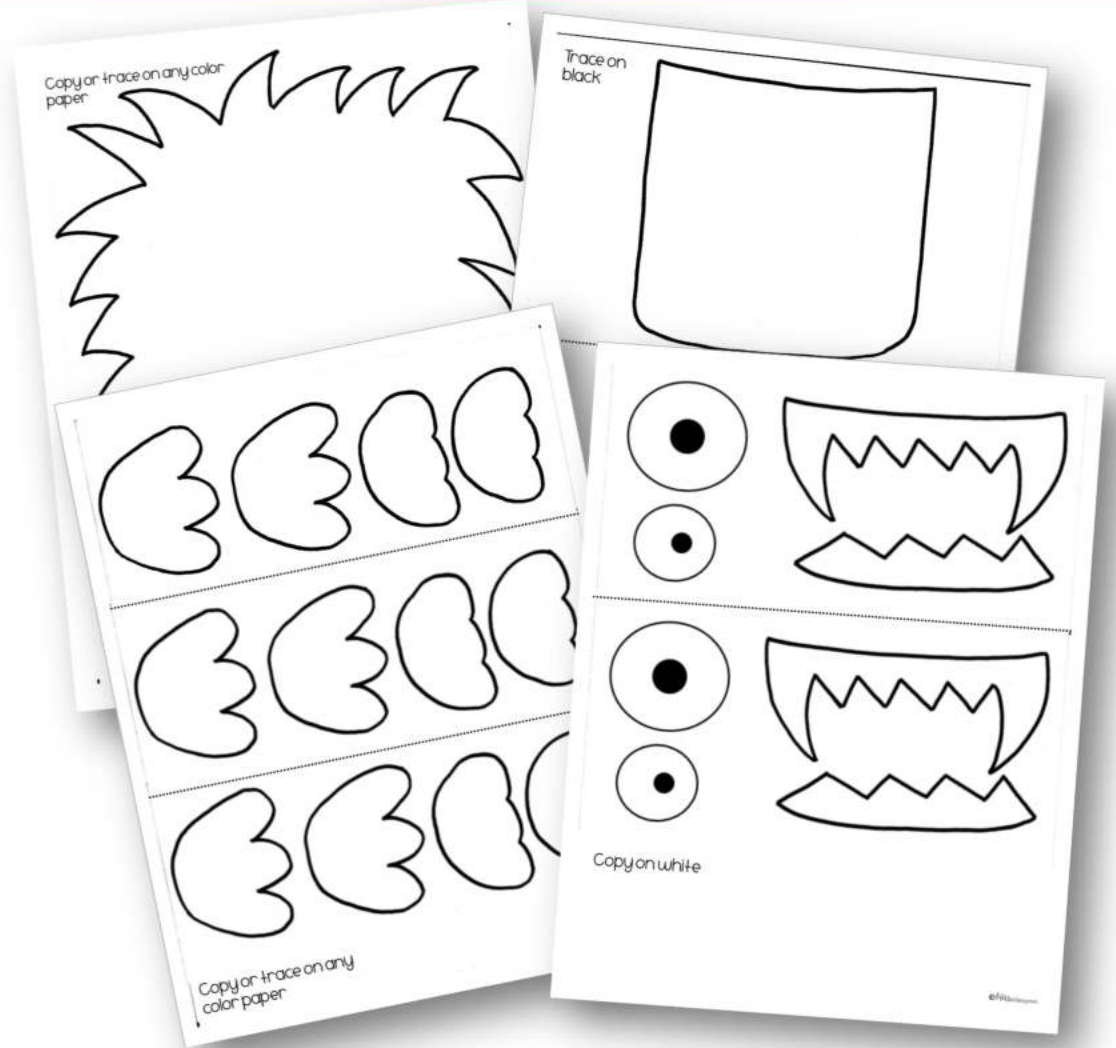

Print on colored paper or have your students color the templates

EASY TO FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS

HOW TO ASSEMBLE

Copy or trace the craft templates onto colored paper.

Step one:
Have your students complete the writing portion of the project first. There are two types of graphic organizers that can be used before the students write. They can describe what their monster looks like, what the monster likes to do, or make up a story about their monster. {If they are describing the color of their monster, make sure they only choose the colors you have available for the craft!}

Step two:
Have your students collect the craft pieces they need and cut out the monster's body and mouth. Help them staple the writing beneath the mouth. {If the cutting seems too difficult for your students, cut the monster's body out before passing them out to your students.}



HOW TO ASSEMBLE

Step three:
Cut out the teeth {very carefully!} and glue them onto the mouth.



Step four:
Cut out two hands and two feet and glue them onto the body.

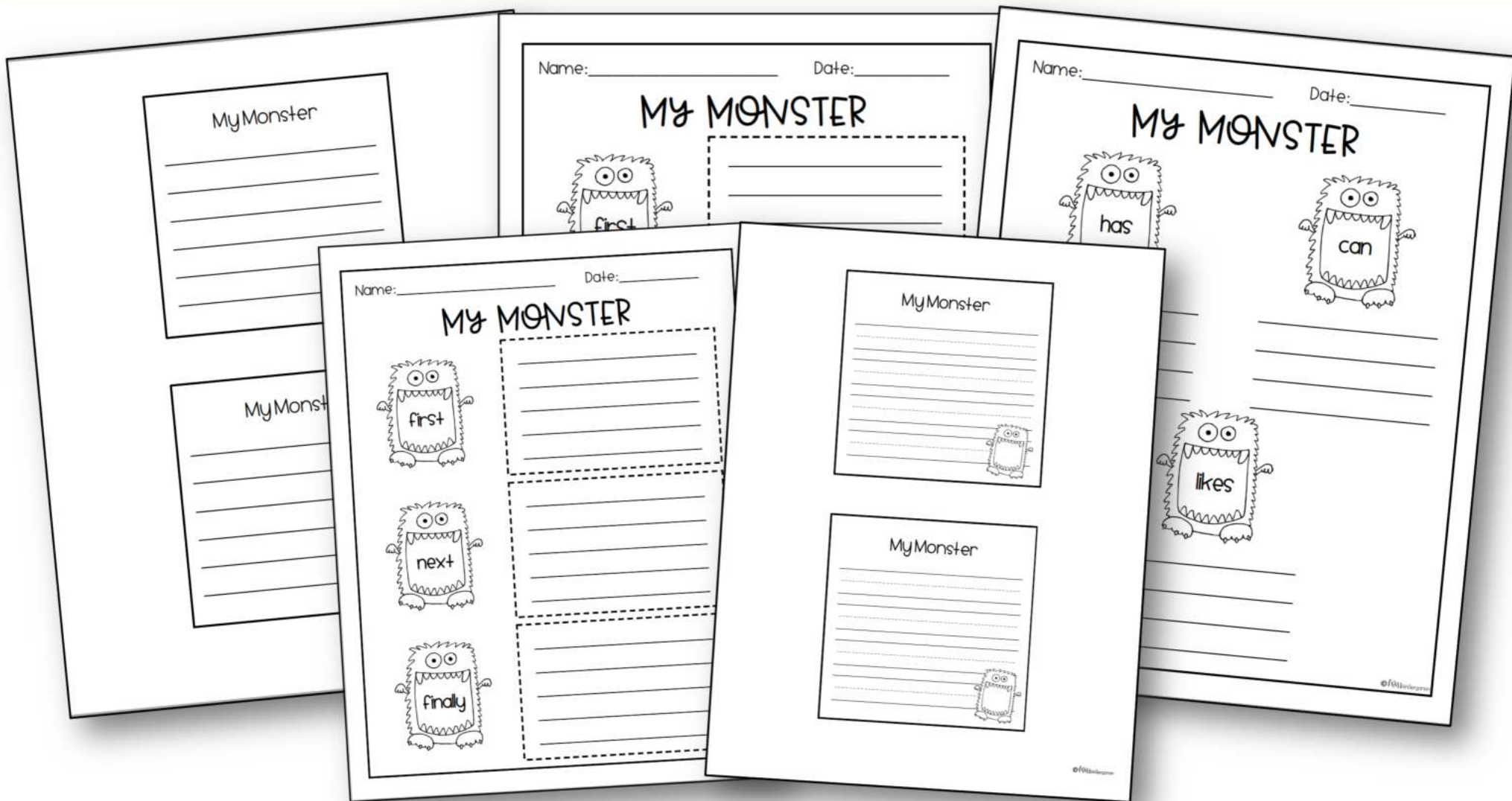
Step five:
Finally, cut out and glue down the eyes. Then, have them cut 6 mini triangles from their scraps to make the toenails. Show them how to put the glue directly onto the toenail so that it doesn't make a huge mess! You can also have them use white crayon to draw toenails on rather than using the paper.

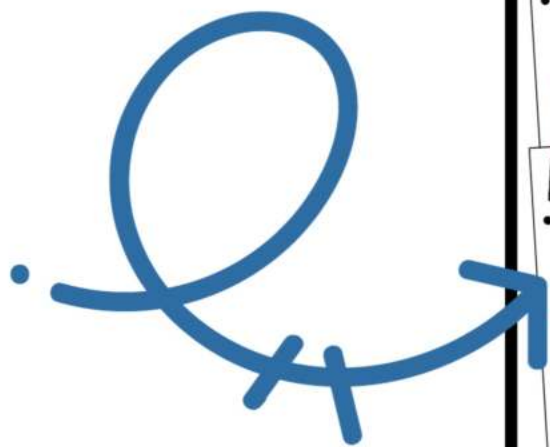
