

Fluency Families Short vowel words in sentences

One of the most important skills for beginning readers to attain is fluency in reading. Fluency means the ability to read text quickly and accurately. When students gain an understanding of word families, and start to see "chunks" in words, they become better readers. Instead of sounding out each phoneme, or sound, in the word, they are able to transfer what they know about "chunks" and apply it to their reading. Word family fluency is a great way for your students to practice reading accurately and fluently. This set of fluency practice has short vowel words in sentences listed on one page. Your students can roll a dice and read the corresponding sentences. The second page has dots under the words to help your students touch each word as they read the sentences. You can print these pages out and place them in sheet protectors. Then place all the sheets in a 3-ring binder for easy access.
