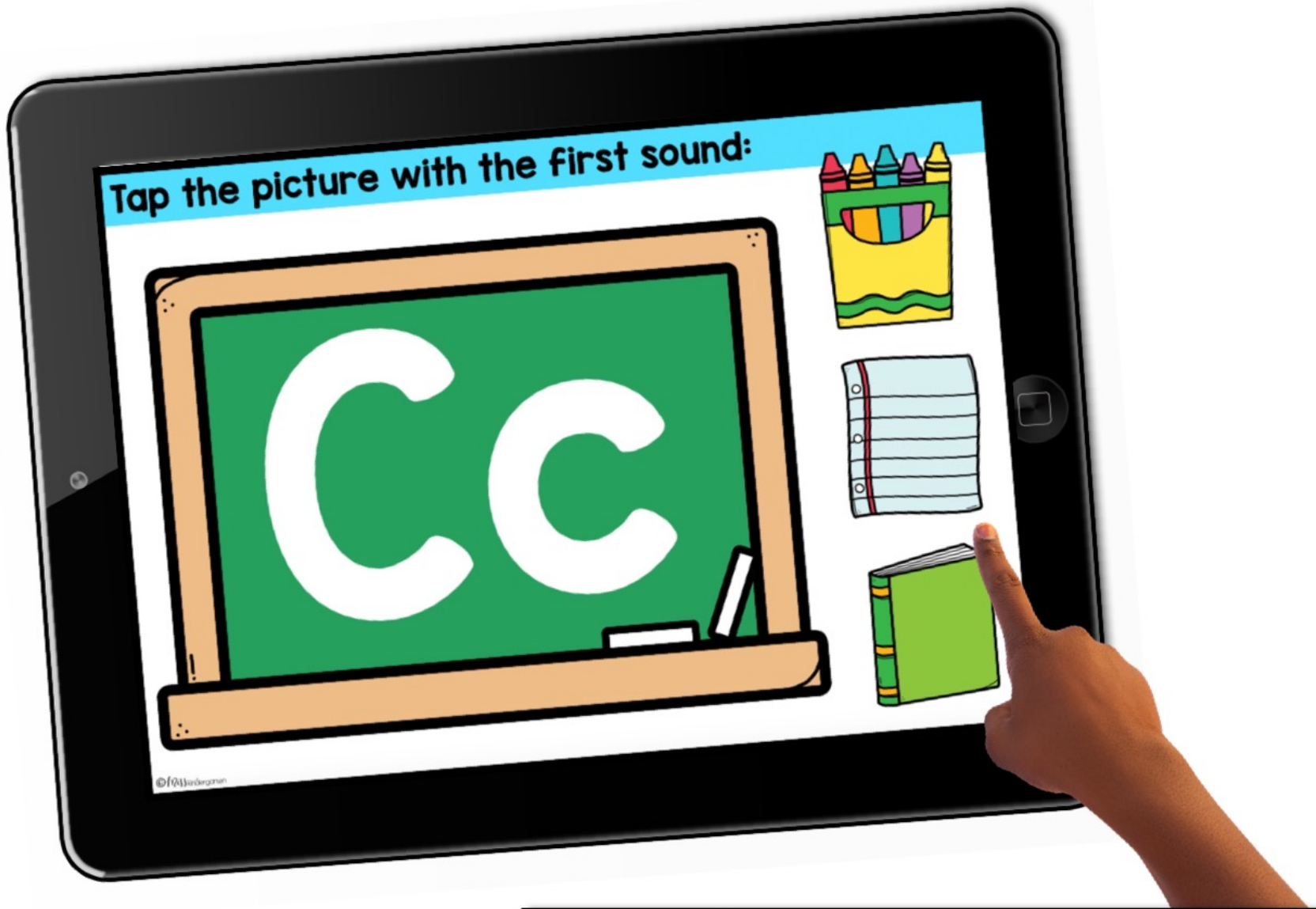


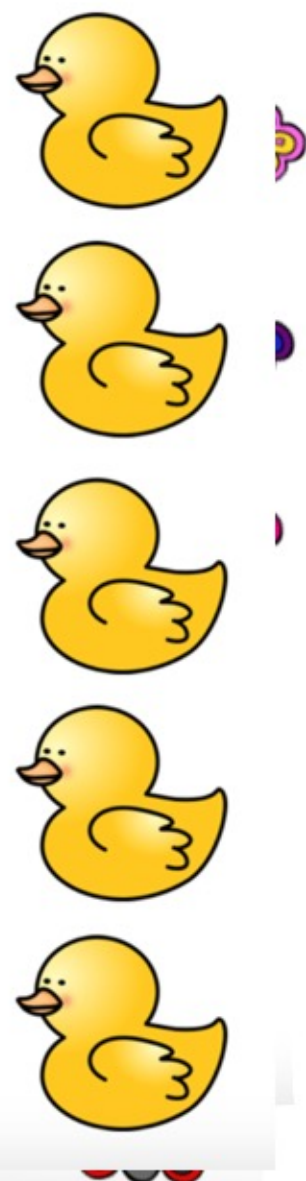

# DRAG & DROP


Help your students become familiar with Boom Cards using these Drag & Drop cards. They can click on the speaker to listen to the directions, then drag the images to the correct spot.

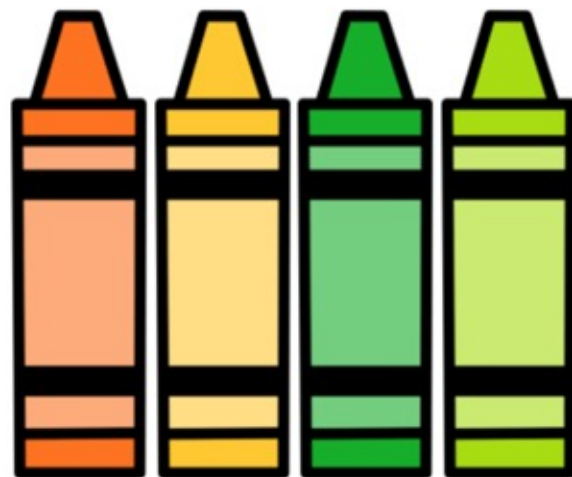
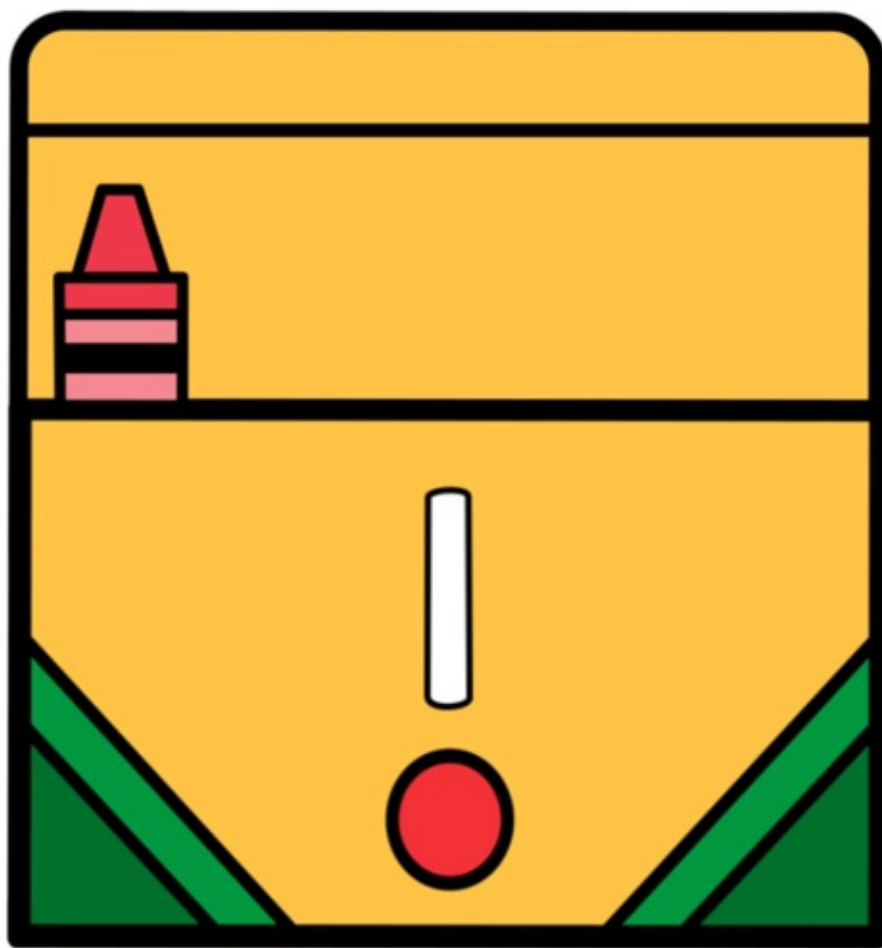

🔊) Fill the crayon box by dragging the crayons over.



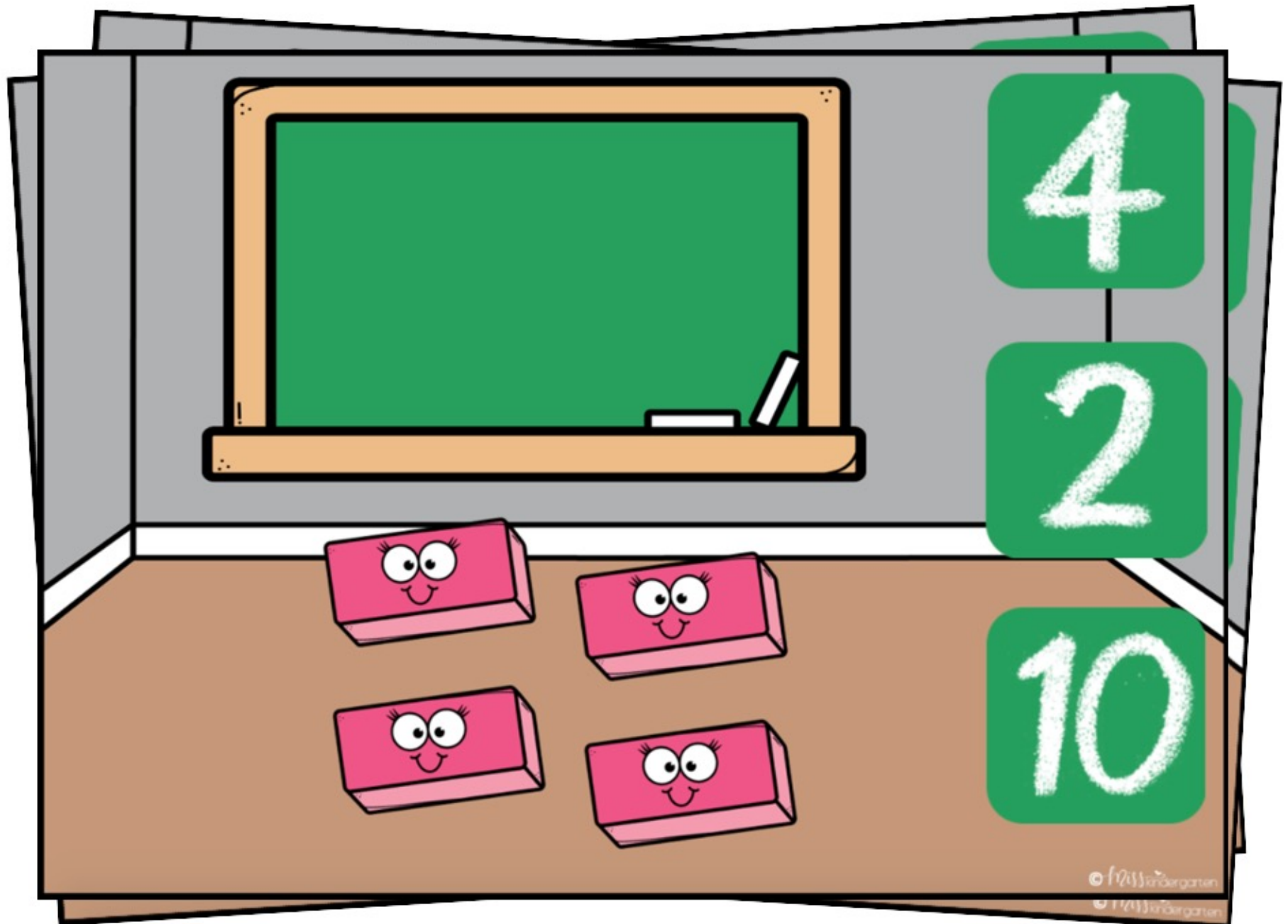
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# COUNTING TO 10

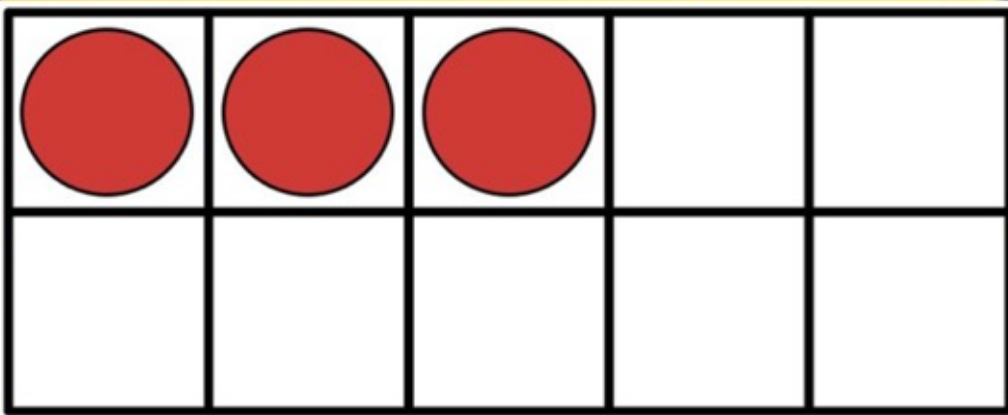
Your students can practice counting and one-to-one correspondence with these cards. After counting, they will drag the correct number to the chalkboard to show how many.

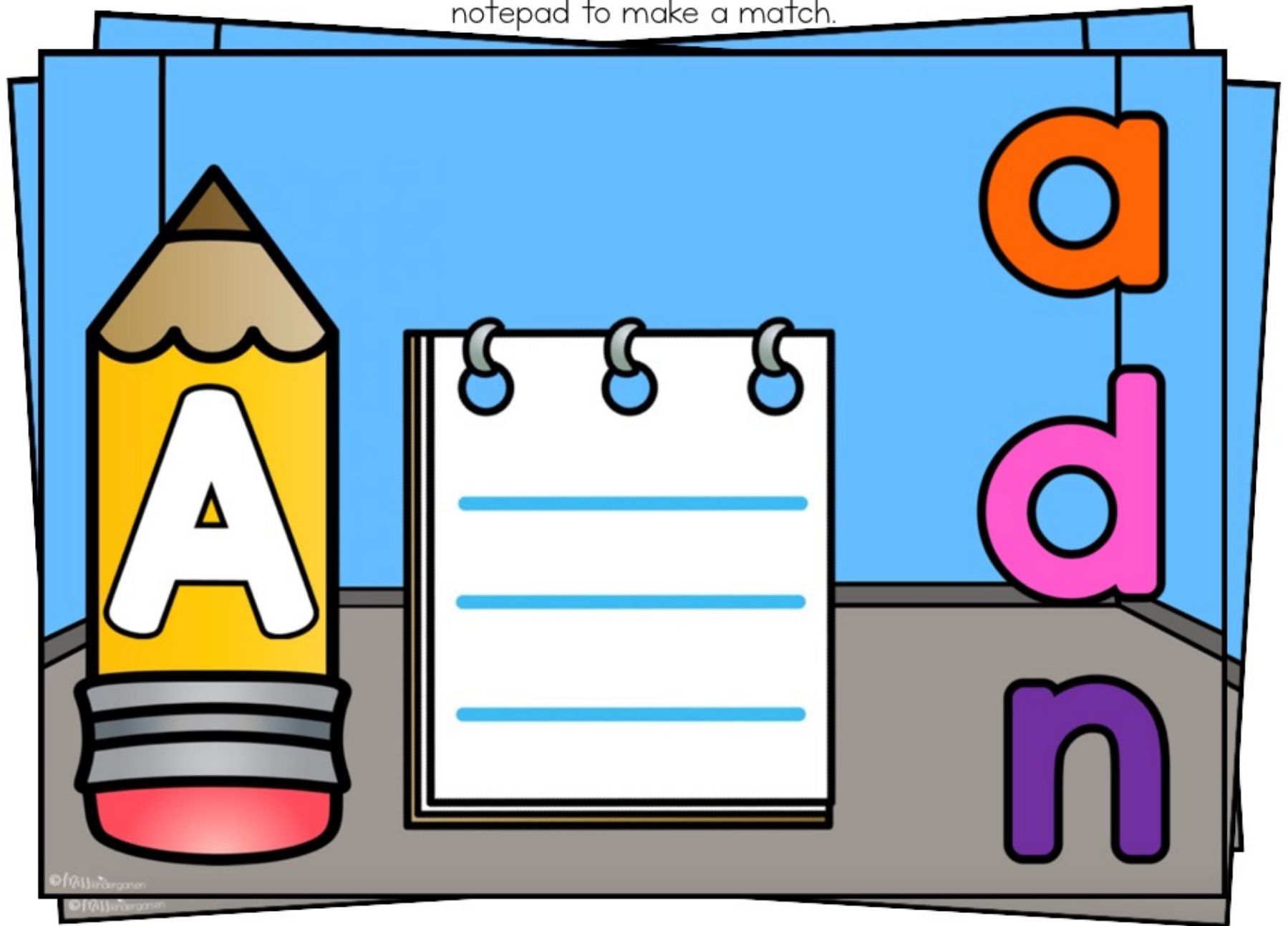

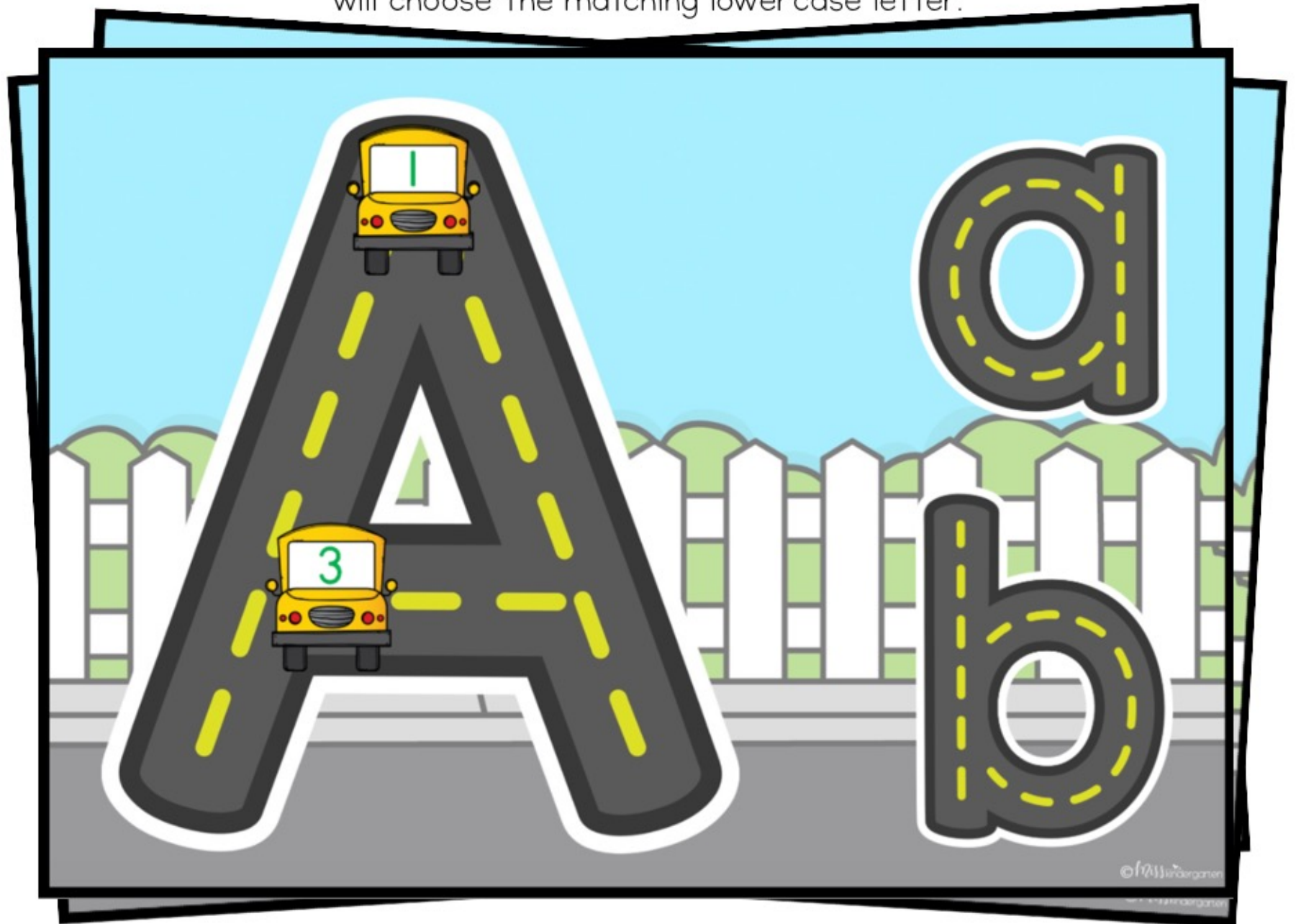
# ALPHABET MATCH

Your students can work on letter formation with these fun road tracing cards! They will drag the bus across the letter (going in number order) to form each letter, then they will choose the matching lowercase letter.



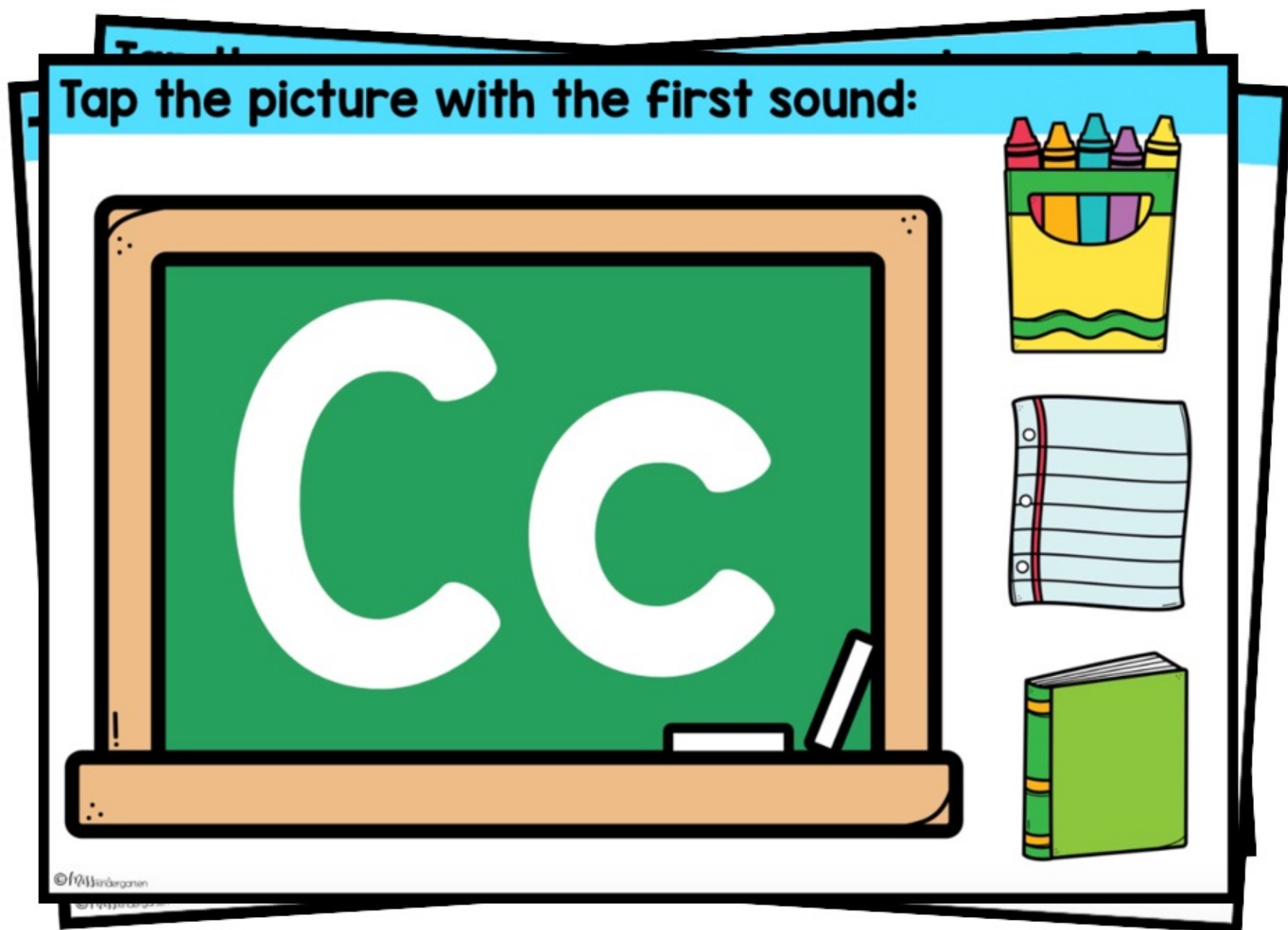
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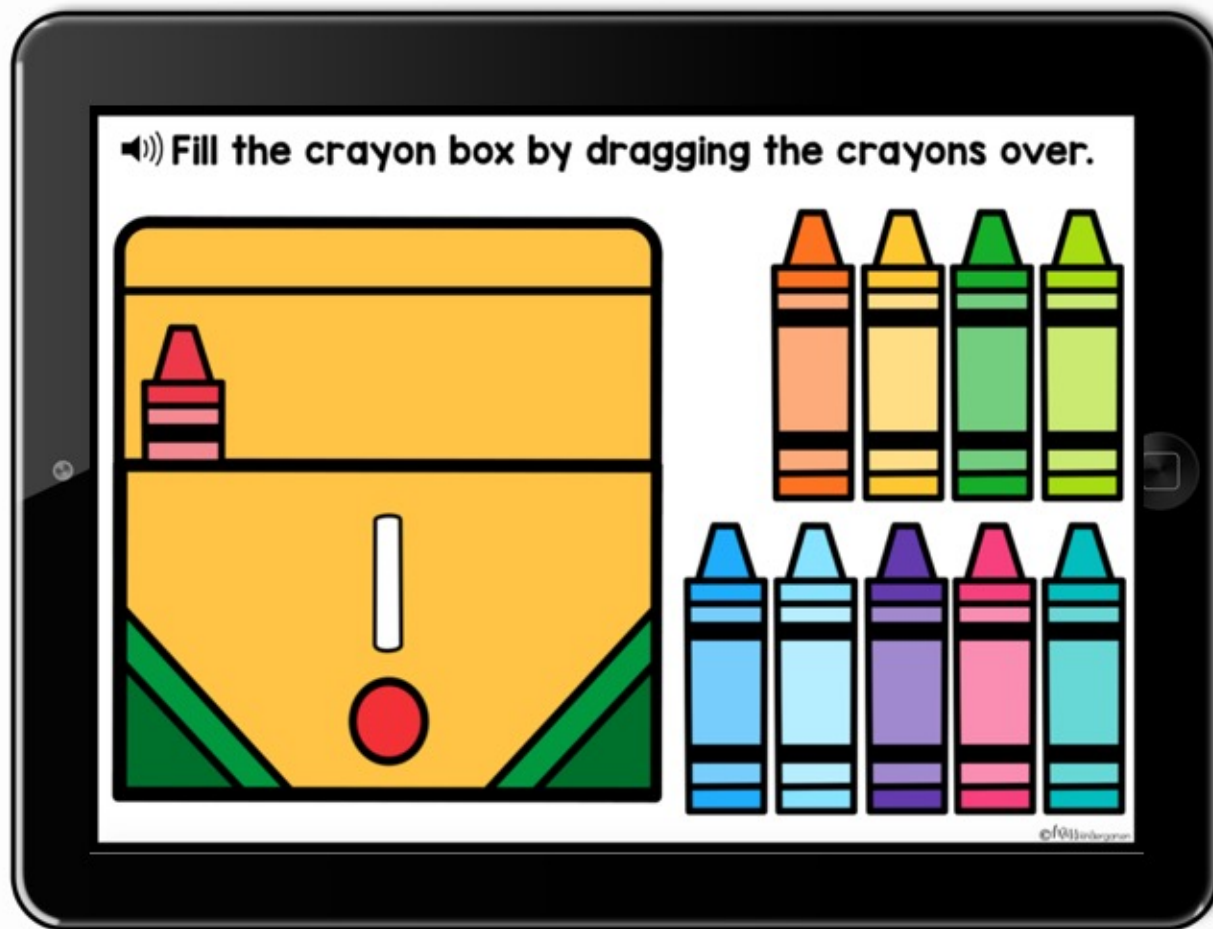
# BEGINNING SOUNDS
