

CRAFT TEMPLATES & ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

FALL LEAF PATTERN CRAFT

Celebrate fall and practice important kindergarten skills with this fun falling leaves craft! Your students can practice creating different patterns with the leaves.

Included in this resource are craft templates and step-by-step directions with pictures. There are several options for the face and hair. Your students can choose which ones they would like to use.

To get started, copy or trace the craft templates onto the correct colored paper.

You can also copy the templates onto white copy paper and have your students color them in directly.

HOW TO ASSEMBLE

Step one:

Have your students cut out the arms and hands, then glue them onto the background. There are guide lines for them to know where to glue the arms to.



HOW TO ASSEMBLE

Step three:

Cut out the hair and glue on top of the head. They can use the bow provided, or create their own.

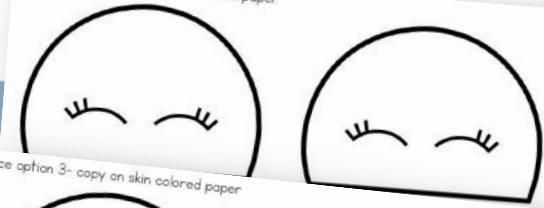


Step four:

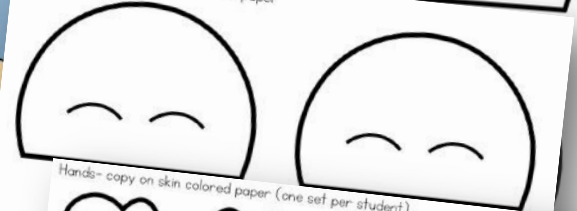
Cut and/or color the leaves. Arrange 6 leaves in a pattern and glue.



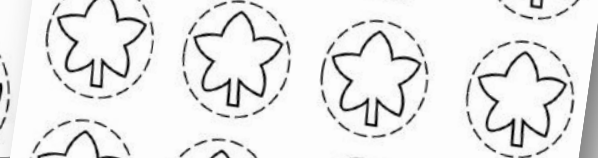
Face option 2- copy on skin colored paper
