

CRAFT TEMPLATES & ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

TURKEY HEADBAND CRAFT

This turkey headband makes the perfect addition to your Fall class party, fall performance, or just for fun!

Your students can write the letters in their name on the feathers. If you'd like to type your students' names onto the Feathers instead, you will find "editable Feathers" included at the end of this file.

Included in this resource are craft templates and step-by-step directions with pictures.

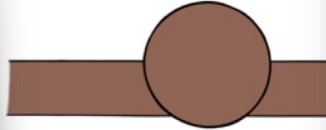
To get started, copy or trace the craft templates onto colored paper. Each student also needs a strip of brown construction paper for the headband measuring 2.5"x18". You can hole punch the ends of the headband and add ribbon to tie it to size, or staple extra paper to size.



HOW TO ASSEMBLE

Step one:

Give each student strip of brown construction paper for the headband measuring 2.5"x18". Have them fold the paper in half and glue the circle in the middle.



Step two:

Cut out the beak, fold it in half, and glue it to the circle. Then cut out the wattle.

HOW TO ASSEMBLE

Step three:

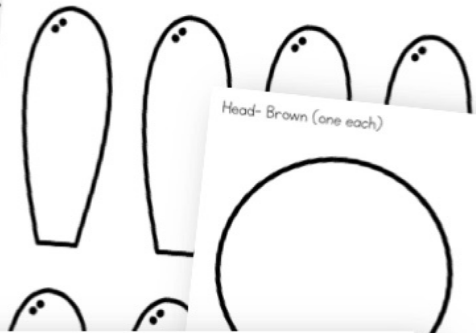
Cut out feathers to spell your name. Glue the feathers behind the headband.



Step four:

Measure the headband to size. Add extra paper or ribbon if needed.

Feathers- Misc. Colors



Head- Brown (one each)



Eyes- White (one pair each)



Wattle- Red (one each)



Orange (one each)
