 - Antonyms: "I can draw and label the antonym" with illustrations of an old person and a full glass.

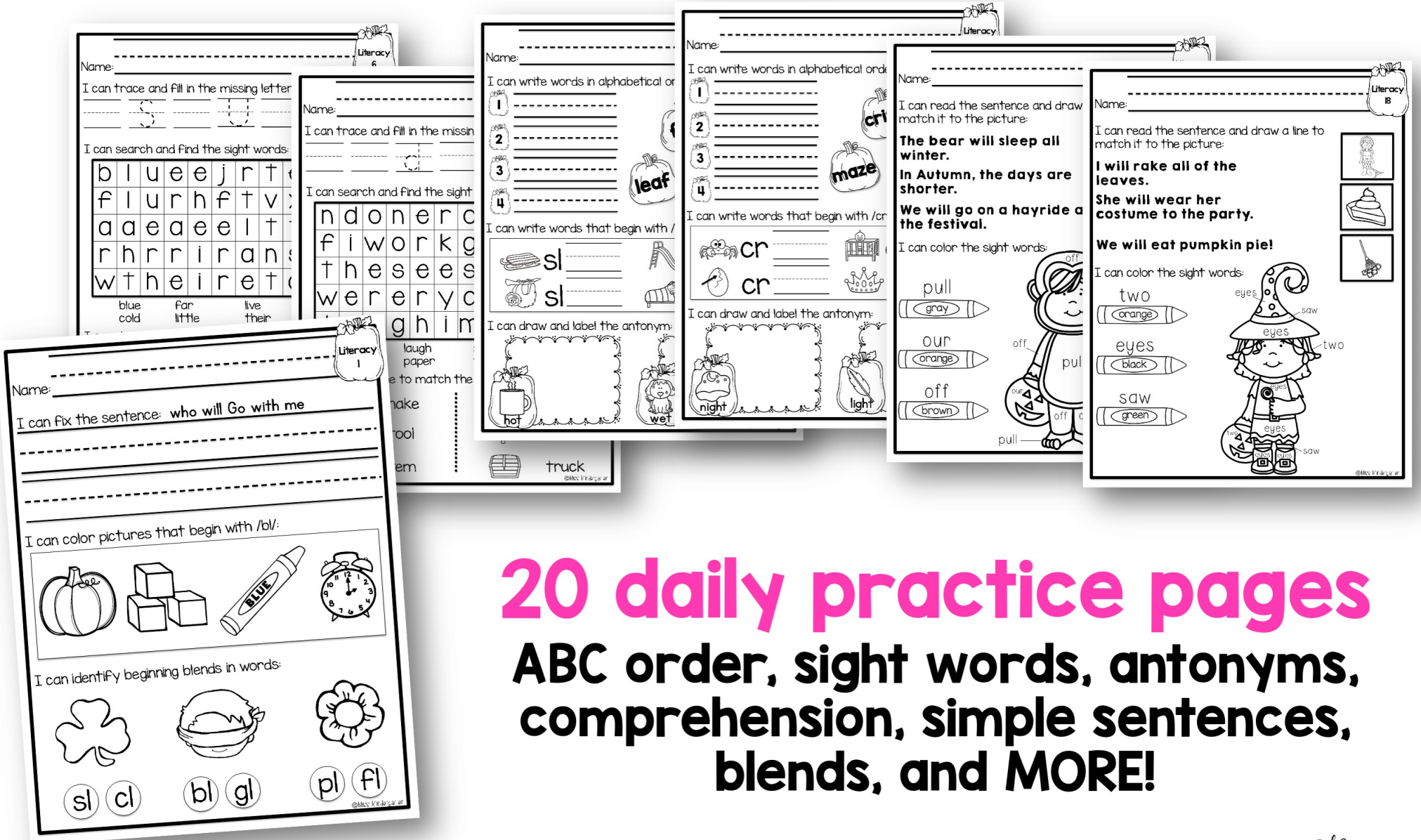
