

CRAFT TEMPLATES & ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

TURKEY NAME CRAFT

Have your students practice building or spelling their names with this fun turkey craft!

Your students can write the letters in their name on the feathers. If you'd like to type your students' names onto the feathers instead, open the file titled "editable feathers".

Included in this resource are craft templates and step-by-step directions with pictures.

To get started, copy or trace the craft templates onto colored paper. You can also copy them onto white paper and have your students color them in.

HOW TO ASSEMBLE

Step One:
Have your students cut out the turkey's head, neck, and feet. Glue them to the top of the body and the feet behind the body.

Step Two:
Have them cut and glue on the eyes. You can also have them add eyes with black crayon.

HOW TO ASSEMBLE

Step Four:
Have your students count the letters in their name and add that many feathers to the turkey. They can write the letters on the feathers, or provide them feathers with the letters already printed.

Optional step:
Glue the completed turkey to a cardstock or paper.
