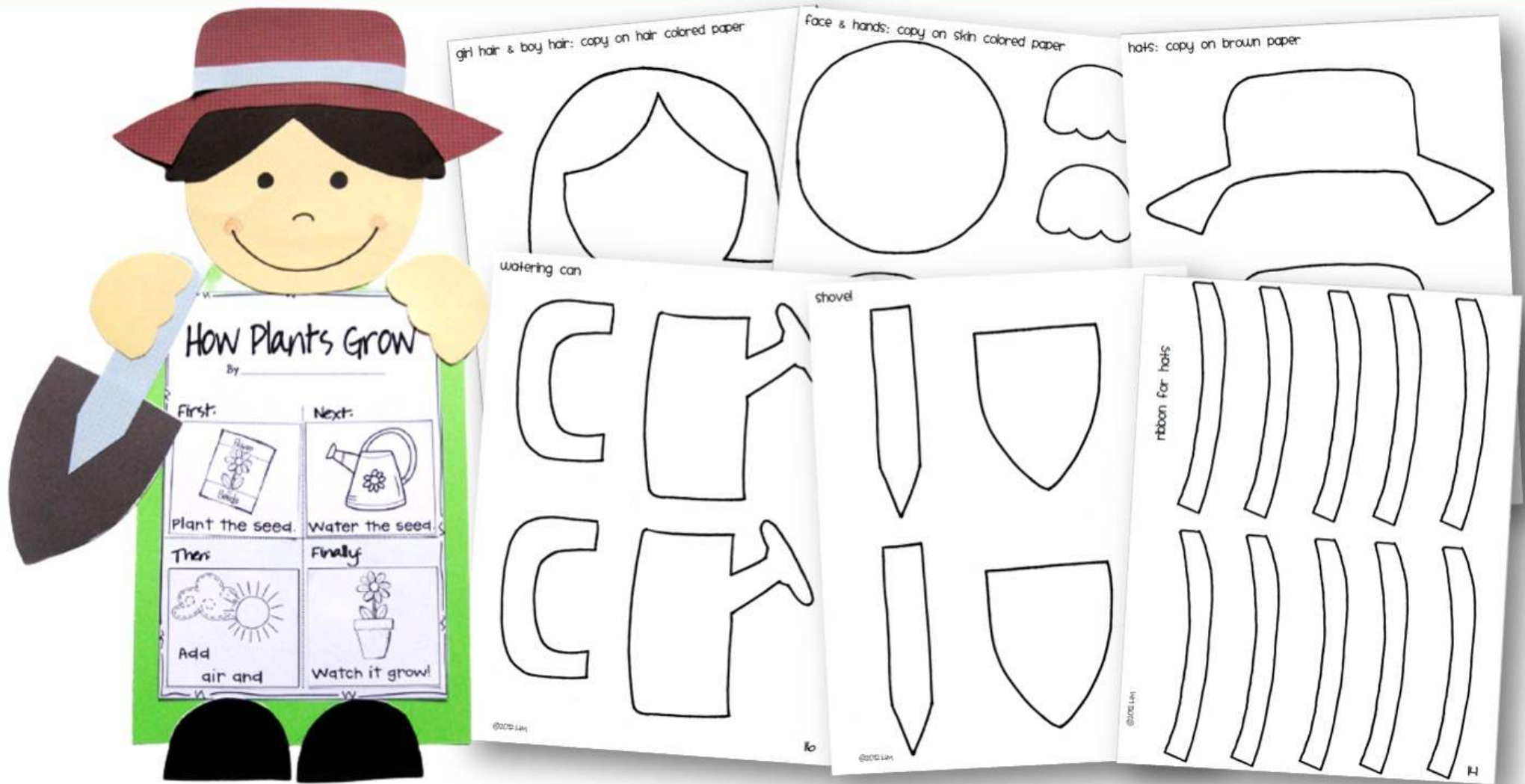

Garden Buddy using 7"x6" paper as a body

Templates:

If you would like to use the templates as tracers, copy pages 5-7 onto cardstock, or another type of thick paper, and trace onto appropriate colored paper.

If you plan on printing the templates directly onto colored paper, use pages 12-18.

To assemble your garden buddy:

1. Cut out each template along with a 7"x6" piece of construction paper or cardstock for the body. If you are attaching writing to the body, staple it to the back or glue it to the front of the body first.
2. Glue the hair onto the head, then glue on the hat. Next, glue the ribbon onto the hat and trim the edges so they are even with the hat.
3. Glue the face onto the top of the 7"x6" paper making sure the paper is long like a door. Place the hands under the face and glue down. (Note: If you plan on using the watering can or the shovel, assemble them first and glue the hand holding the handle before gluing it onto the body)
4. Glue the shoes on the very bottom.
5. Add eyes, nose and a smile.

Garden buddies with outfits

If you would like to use the templates as tracers, copy onto cardstock, or another type of thick paper, onto appropriate colored paper. The garden outfits on pages 7-10 need to be cut out and traced onto paper. Attach the top half of the dress to the bottom before tracing it to make a complete dress. Cut out patterns and attach at the dashed lines before

printing the templates directly onto colored pages 12-18.

Glue the shoes on the very bottom.



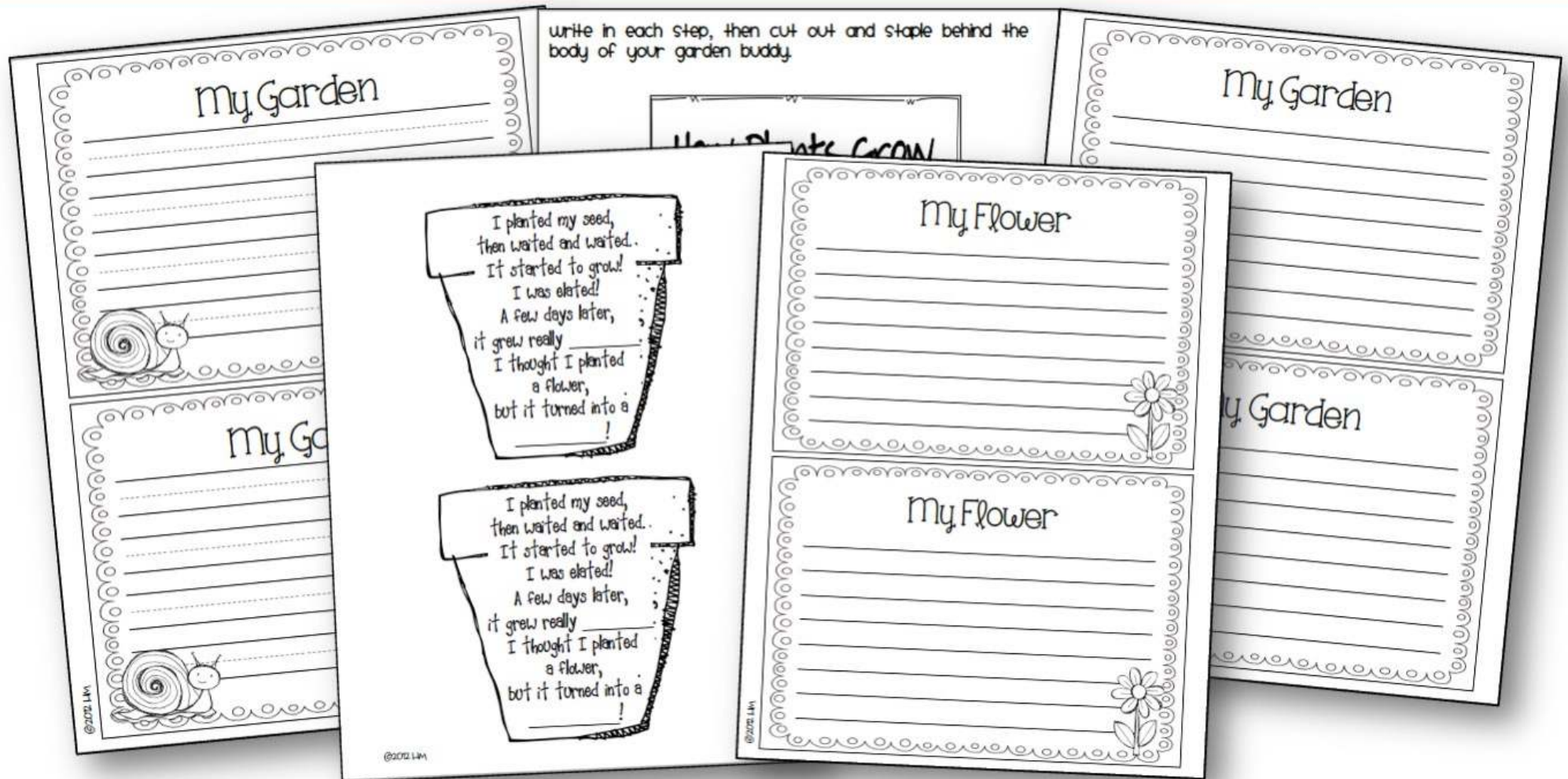
